

Trap Procedure.

Recommendation

- a) Trap will be held on Tuesdays starting at the 3:00 with each round of 25 shots costing \$4:00.

- b) Procedure
 1. Have shooters sign in using trap scoring sheets
 2. When shooters register each shooter will sign the Waiver sheet.
 3. The rules of the range will be reviewed with all shooters
 4. Once there are 5 registered shooters a team will be formed and will shoot on trap range 1. Only trap ranges 1 and 2 will be used.
 5. If a team comes with 5 shooters that team will be assigned the next open trap range.
 6. After two rounds on each range shooting will be stopped and the trap houses will be checked for the need of birds. A cone will be placed on the top of the trap house to indicate that someone is down range
 7. If juniors shoot (under 18) the first round will be free and the remaining rounds will be \$2.00 each.
 8. When each squad completes their rounds, the proper amount of money will be collected.

- c) What to bring
 1. Eye protection
 2. Ear protection
 3. Shotgun
 4. 25 shells for each round

- d) At the end of all rounds the S.L.C.F.S.A. Committee Activity Report will be completed.

- e) Possible Saturday trap shoots: The fourth Saturday of each month.

- f) Rules
 1. All shotguns unloaded and barrels open or chambers open
 2. Shotguns will only be loaded at the stations
 3. Shotguns are always pointed down range

4. At the end of each round shotguns will be secured and all shells will be picked up (if a squad is shooting multiple rounds this procedure can be done at the end of the rounds)
